SYSTEM SUMMARY TABLE

The following System Summary Table summarizes the most important characteristics of the major experimental and operational computer-assisted legal research (CALR) projects throughout the world. The information contained in the Table was extracted from published materials available to the Journal's editorial staff, as well as correspondence with individuals personally familiar with many of the systems. The systems are arranged by country in the following order: United States of America, Canada, Council of Europe, and then all other countries in alphabetical order.

While great care has been taken to insure the accuracy of the information contained in the Table, the fluidity of CALR system development assures that by the time a status report reaches print, it is out-of-date. Additionally, documentation on some of the systems was sketchy at best, and various information was simply not available prior to publication.

Since this issue will be updated periodically, the editors would appreciate receiving any information concerning future changes in existing systems, or the appearance of new systems.
